New Swiss Space Policy

On 19 April 2023, the Federal Council adopted the 2023 Space Policy. With this policy, the rapid developments and increasing importance of space are taken into account: satellite-based applications have become an indispensable part of everyday life. In its 2023 Space Policy, the Federal Council has defined strategic priorities and corresponding areas of activity. Several departments are now charged with implementing the Policy; they will report to the Federal Council on their progress by end of June 2027.


News Channel UZH Space Hub on Microsoft Teams
