

We would like to congratulate UZH Spin-off Synthara for joining the ESA Business Incubator Centre (BIC) acceleration program! Synthara is taking care of the design of energy efficient AI chips, that intelligently reconfigure themself in real-time, consuming the least possible amount of energy, and allow multiple channel combination of information from multiple sensors. If you are also interested in such an opportunity, ESA BIC provides business, technical and financial support up to 200k euros for new space-related start-up projects or existing Swiss start-ups less than 5 years old. This is a great opportunity to push your business, getting not only the network support, but also the possibility to access ESA network and facilities.
